360 individuals **with housing** were asked about the stability and security of their current housing situations. Of these, 26% (94) indicated that they were at <u>immediate risk</u> of losing their housing due inability to pay rent, concerns for personal safety, building maintenance/safety issues, and/or interpersonal conflict.
