Nelson CARES Society is a not-for-profit organization that provides programs and initiatives in advocacy, housing, employment support services, and environmental stewardship. The Kootenay Seniors Program is one of its programs that provides information, resources, and services for seniors.

Job Summary: This position is part of the Kootenay Seniors Program team and will be mainly responsible for planning, implementing, and preparing social meals for seniors. The goal of this program is to provide seniors with a meal and social interaction.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. In collaboration with the Kootenay Seniors staff, creates menus and shopping lists.
- 2. Ensures the cleanliness and safety of the kitchen and meal preparation according to health and safety standards.
- 3. Registers participants.
- 4. Oversees volunteer recruitment, training, and supervision.
- 5. Ensures kitchen is well organized and functional.
- 6. Maintains good communication with staff and participants.
- 7. Must have access to a reliable vehicle, carry appropriate insurance as per policy, and use the vehicle for the purpose of working from multiple locations.
- 8. Promotes the program through social media, postering, and coordinating with other senior organizations.
- 9. Develops collaborative relationships with community and health services organizations.
- 10. Ensures that the program follows relevant Nelson CARES/HR policies and procedures.
- 11. Collects project statistics and client data as required.
- 12. Performs other related duties as assigned by the Manager.
